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**Sixth Grade:** Christ Our Life. God Calls a People. Loyola Press. Workbook - \$25. This class is devoted to the study of God's saving love as it is revealed in Sacred Scripture, particularly the Old Testament. *God Calls a People* is designed to help the students increase their knowledge of salvation history so that they may respond to God with ever-deepening love and gratitude.

**Seventh Grade:** Christ Our Life. Jesus the Way, the Truth, and the Life. Loyola Press. Workbook - \$25. This class focuses on the study of God's saving love as it is revealed through his Son, Jesus. *Jesus the Way, the Truth, and the Life* is designed to help young adolescents grow in their knowledge of Jesus, that they may love him more ardently and serve him more generously.

**Eighth Grade:** Christ Our Life. The Church then and Now. Loyola Press. Workbook - \$25. This course is devoted to the study of God's faithful love as it is revealed in the Church founded by Jesus Christ. *The Church then and Now* is designed to help young teens grow in their knowledge and love of the Church.

**Classroom Rules and Expectations:**

**Supplies:** Students should come to class each day with their workbook, composition book for notes, writing utensil, their agenda book and homework folder.

**Homework/Late Assignments:** Students should properly and consistently use their agenda books. Assignments will be marked down 25% for one day late, 50% for the second day late, and 75% for the third day late. No credit after three days.

**Extra Credit:** There is NO opportunity for extra credit. Students should complete assignments on time and study for tests and quizzes.

**Composition Books:** Class notes will be written in the composition book. These books must be kept neat and complete. They should be used as a source for studying for tests and quizzes.

**Workbooks:** Workbooks **must** be covered with clear contact paper.

**Folders:** The plastic homework folder is the student's homework folder for all classes. Homework to be completed should be on one side. On the other side will be homework ready to be turned in to the teacher. This folder should be cleaned out regularly.

**Plagiarism/Cheating:** Taking credit for someone else's work will not be tolerated. If a student plagiarizes on any assignment, they will receive a zero for that assignment and/or further punishment. Copying another student's homework will result in a zero on the assignment for BOTH students.

**Absences:** Students will have one day to complete assignments for each day they miss. It is the responsibility of the student to properly make up work.

**Grade Formula:** The final grade is determined by the points earned on homework, classwork, projects, quizzes, and tests divided by total points.
